

As much as I never liked Vegas back in the 70's and 80's, I felt a sad longing for the "rat pack" Vegas having been replaced by this fake theme park version.



Me on the interior balcony walkway outside our room overlooking the Luxor lobby






March 2012 - Las Vegas, Nevada Above - View of Luxor lobby from 15th floor walkway Below - View from our hotel window
















































