
Little Small was little and small. That's how he got the name Little Small.













Little Small was always asking Big Tall questions, but Big Tall didn't mind answering.

"What's it like to be close to the sky?" Little Small wanted to know.




Stretching his neck and looking up to the sky, Big Tall said, "I can see the tops of trees, and over there I see a bird flying by."







"Your world is so much bigger than mine," said Little Small.


Big Tall said, "It only seems that way. Tell me Little Small, what do you see?



Little Small looked around and said, "I can see an army of ants hurrying on their way."









Little Small scratched his head and thought for a minute.

"Being big and tall or little and small are just two different ways to see the world."







