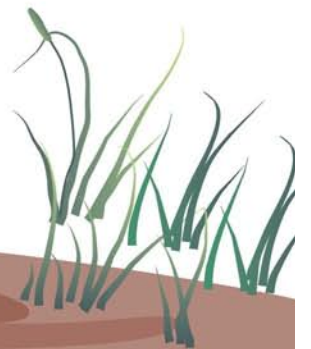
Little Small was little and small. That's how he got the name Little Small.







Big Tall was big and tall. That's how he got the name Big Tall.





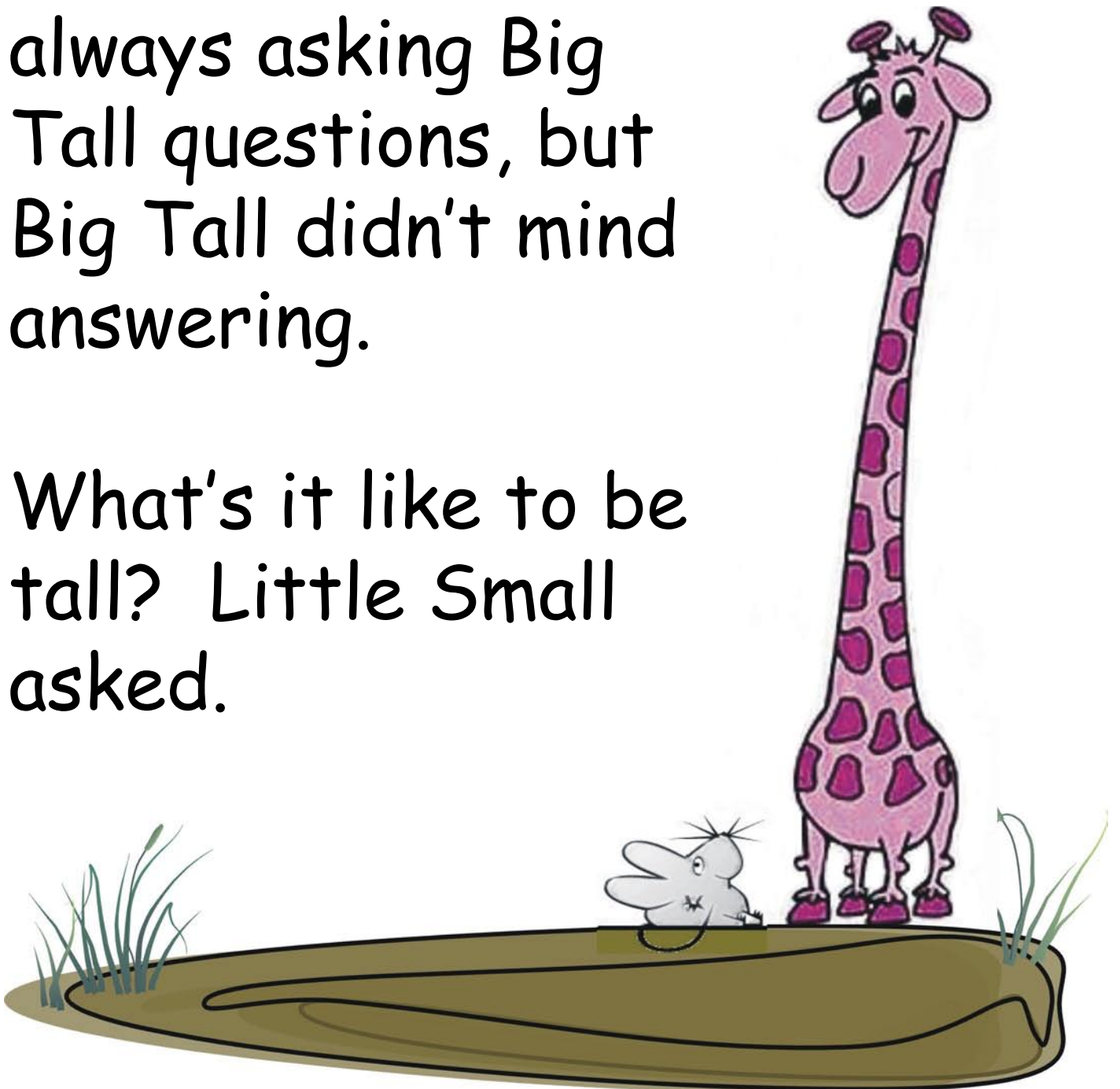
Little Small was

Little Small was always asking Big Tall questions, but Big Tall didn't mind answering.

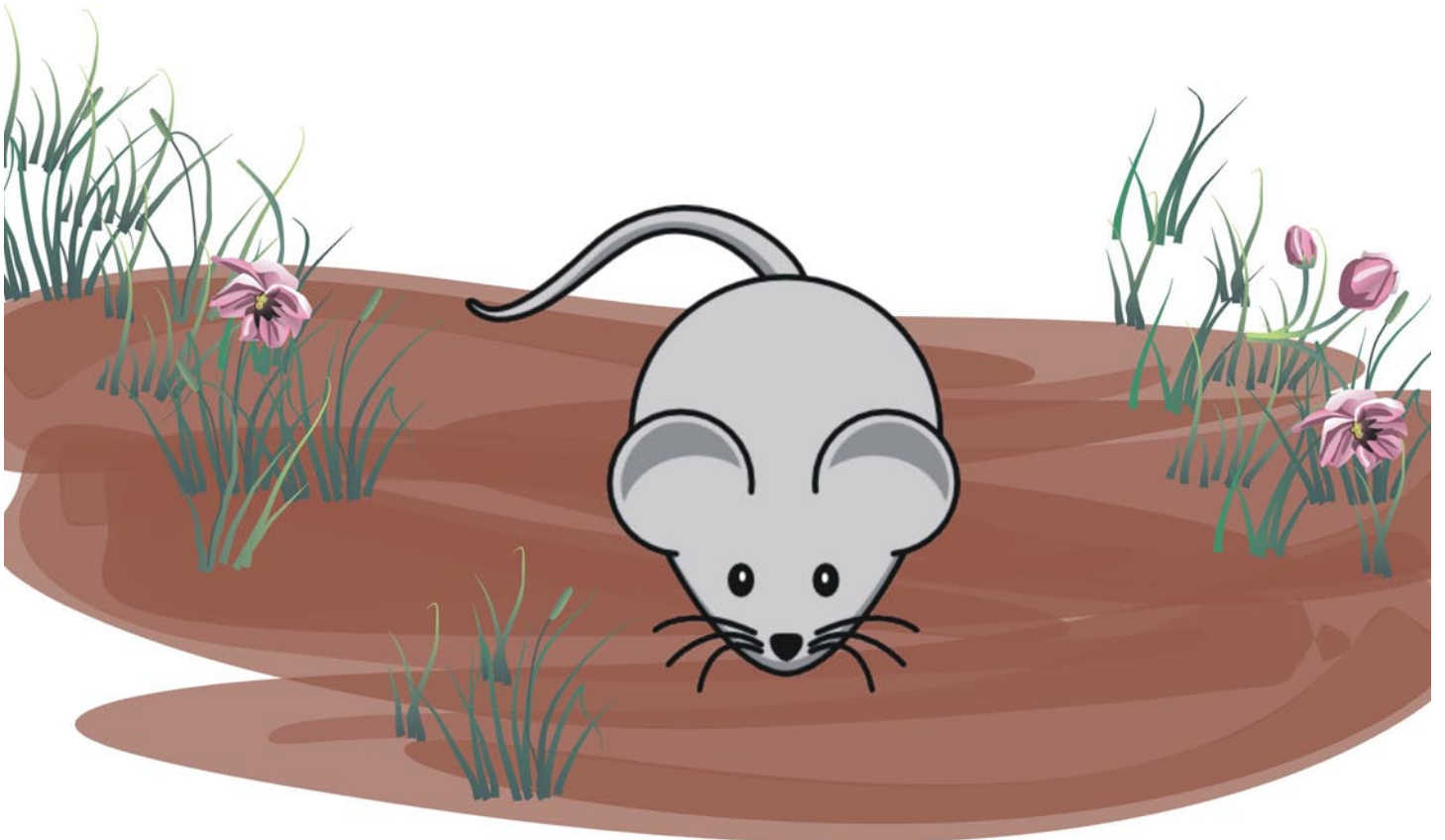
What's it like to be tall? Little Small asked.

"What's it like to be close to the sky?" Little Small wanted to know.



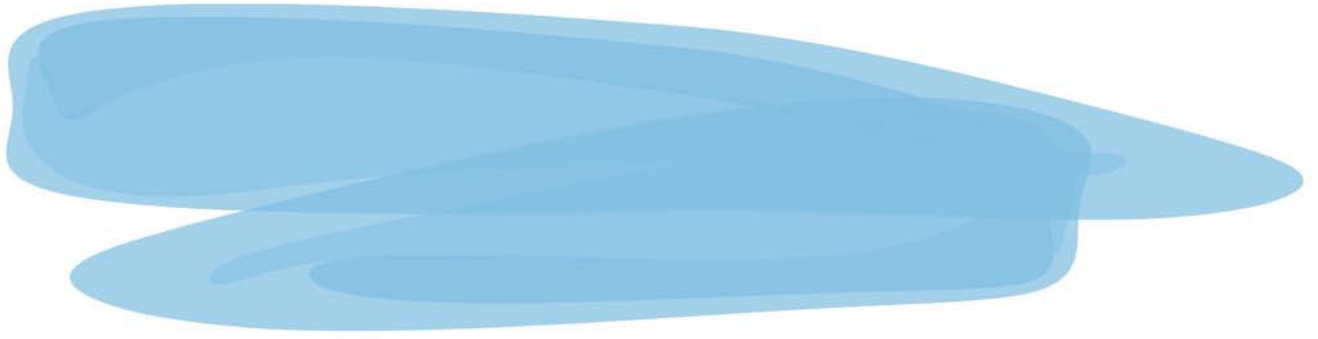
Stretching his neck and looking up to the sky, Big Tall said, "I can see the tops of trees, and over there I see a bird flying by."



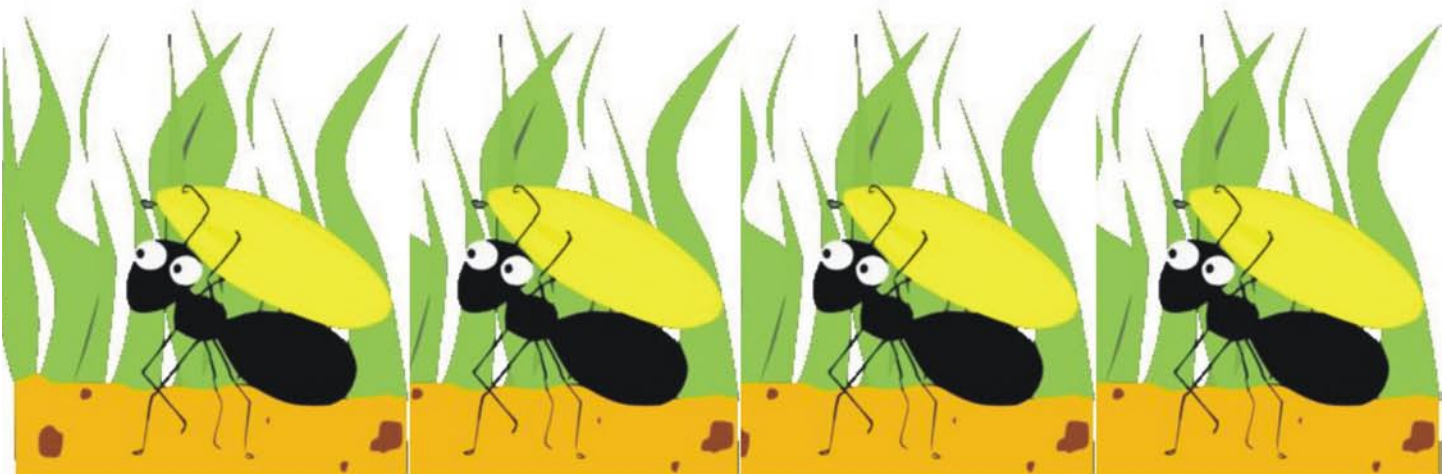


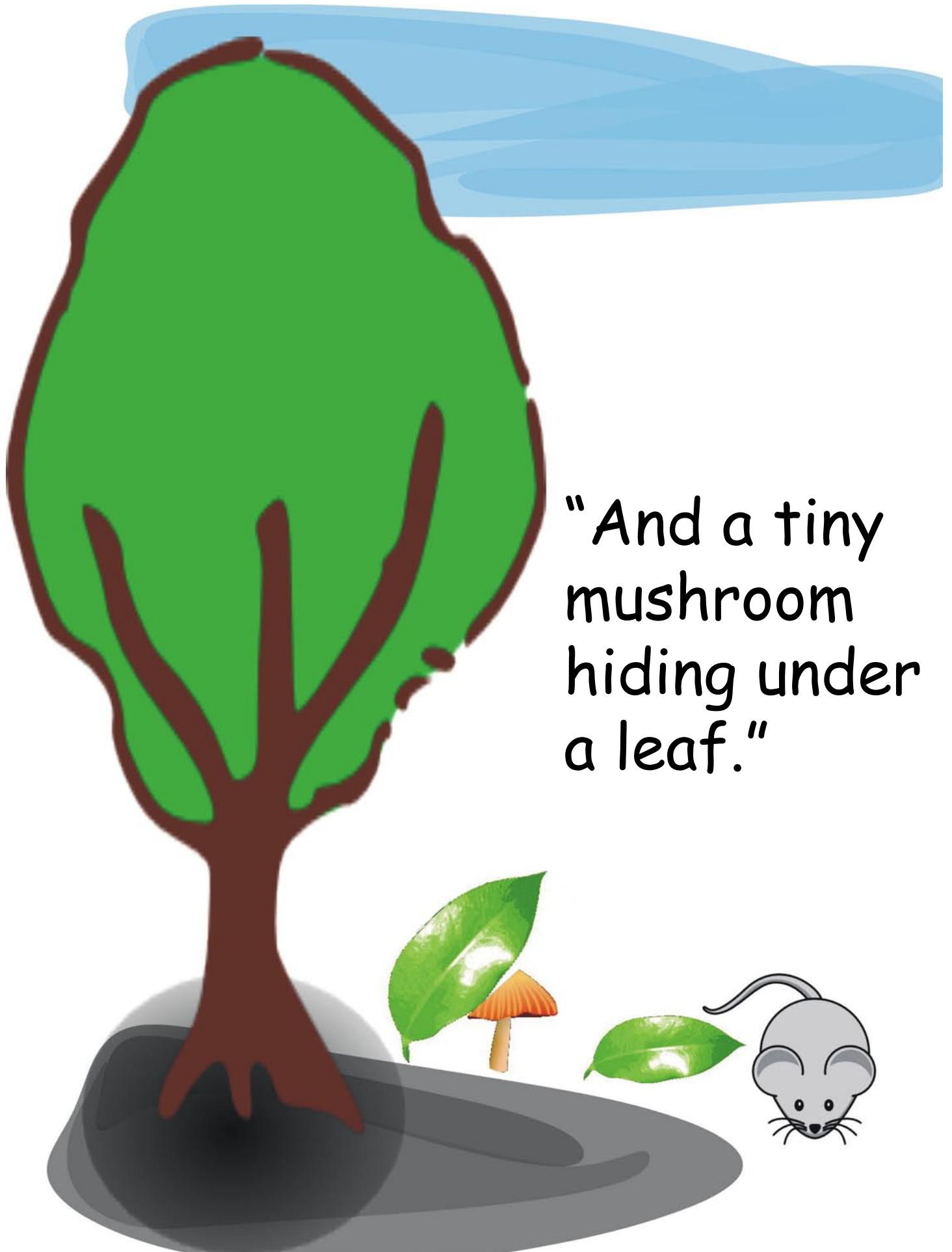
"Your world is so much bigger than mine," said Little Small.

Big Tall said, "It only seems that way. Tell me Little Small, what do you see?"

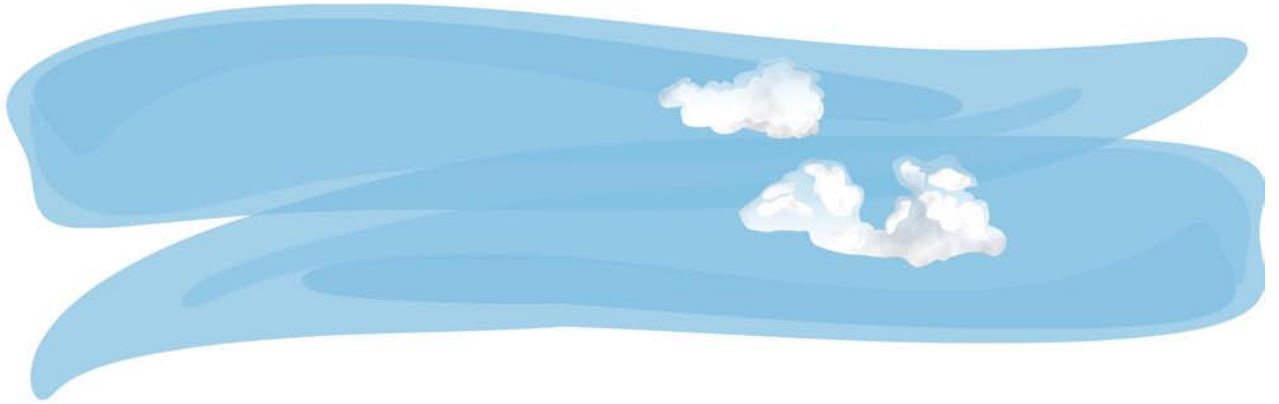


Little Small looked around and said, "I can see an army of ants hurrying on their way."



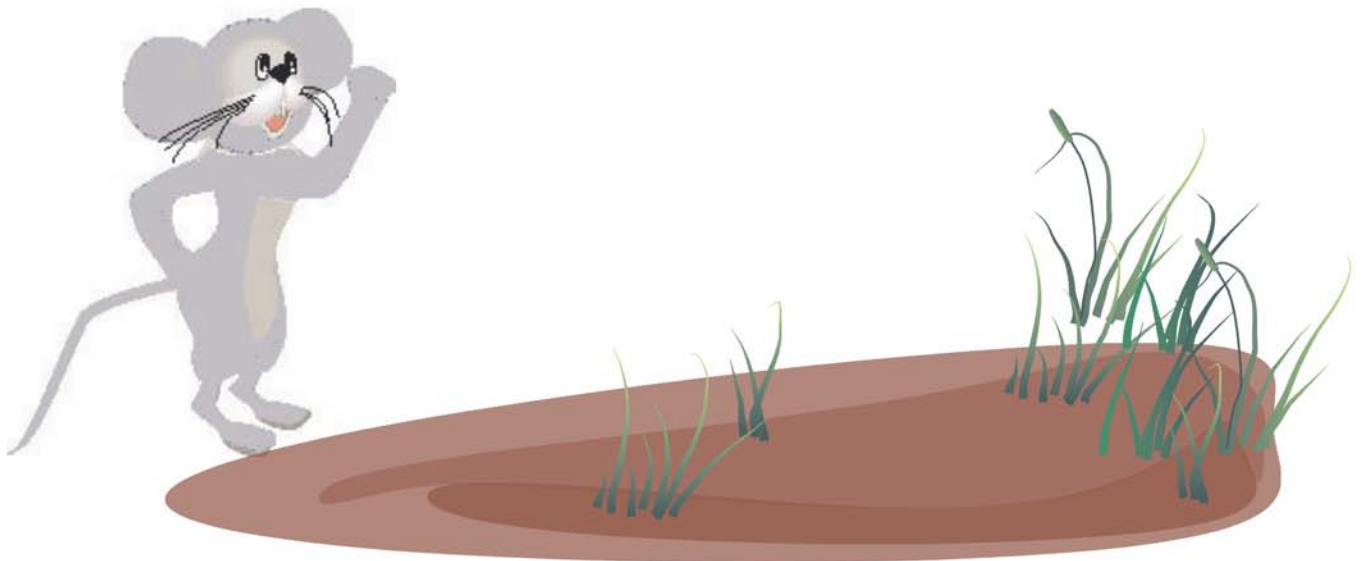


"And a tiny

big and tall....

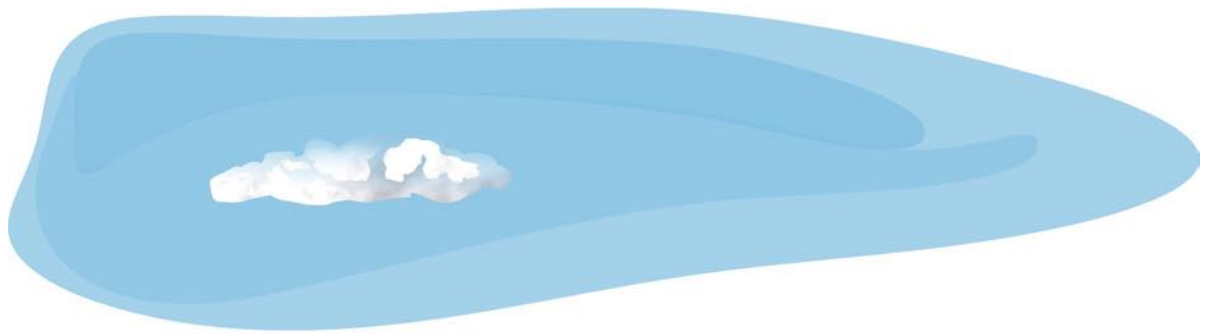
